A Message from the Director

I am happy to announce the building will again be open by appointment beginning Tuesday, May 4. We will continue to provide curbside pick-up to those who prefer it and encourage our patrons to continue using curbside if they are just picking up holds. Browsing, public computers, copiers and fax machines will all be available by appointment. We will continue to require masks inside the library, just as we do for curbside pickup. Hand sanitizer will be at the door as you enter for your appointment and we ask that all patrons sanitize before entering.

In conjunction with many other libraries in Westchester, and per CDC recommendations, we have eased the quarantine length for items returned by patrons and for interlibrary loans. You will begin to receive your items more quickly as we change this quarantine period. Fines will continue to be forgiven for the foreseeable future.

We appreciate your patience as we safely begin opening the library building to our patrons. We very much look forward to seeing all of you in person again.
