Two parallel and eventually intersecting fundraising paths

- Changing our World's approach to major donors, currently in quiet phase
- Budget vote tax increase will be to pay for loan (bond)
- We have time to prepare what we will say to the public and how
- Still trying to speak with Ossining public library, will reach out to Briarcliff as well, to learn from their experience

We need to carefully manage the messaging

Clarity and consistency is needed between the two paths

- Be aware of what's happening in our community at the same time we're telling the public
- Different audiences may be reached in different ways (e.g. events, social media)
- Could more carefully examine annual appeal respondents, silent auction bidders for key donors and members of different social networks
- Staff should be informed before we go public
- We need to create a timeline of different events, activities, publications etc and this will likely not be only one committee
- May use many existing public outreach methods

Bond process

- Unsure whether a municipal bond is needed given low interest rates
- In process of speaking to placement agents to learn how to obtain a loan
- There is still time to learn more
